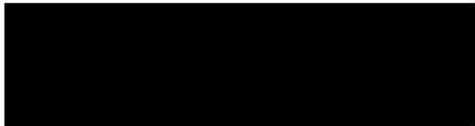

**Re: Your request for access to information under Part II of the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act, 2015* [Our File #: MA/31/2017]**

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On March 27, 2017, the Department of Municipal Affairs and Environment received your request for access to the following records/information:

*“Correspondence (including emails and formal letters) between the Town Of Port aux Basques and the Department of Municipal Affairs, from Jan. 1, 2013, to current day.”*

On March 30, 2017, after seeking clarification, the request was changed to:

*“A list of all approved Municipal Infrastructure projects for the Town of Port aux Basques from January 1, 2013 to present.”*

In accordance with your request for a copy of the records, the appropriate copies have been enclosed.

The Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act requires us to provide an advisory response within 10 days of receiving the request. As this request has been completed prior to day 10, this letter also serves as our Advisory Response.

Please be advised that you may ask the Information and Privacy Commissioner to review the processing of your access request, as set out in section 42 of the Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the Act). A request to the Commissioner must be made in writing within 15 business days of the date of this letter or within a longer period that may be allowed by the Commissioner.

You may also appeal directly to the Supreme Court Trial Division within 15 business days after you receive the decision of the public body, pursuant to section 52 of the Act.

Please be advised that responsive records will be published following a 72 hour period after the response is sent electronically to you or five business days in the case where records are mailed to you. It is the goal to have the responsive records posted to the Completed Access to Information Requests website within one business day following the applicable period of time. Please note that requests for personal information will not be posted online.
