On April 10, 2018 Tourism, Culture, Industry and Innovation received your request for access to the following records:

Request TCII/9/2018 was for List of Commercial companies receiving grants through the Department of Tourism, Culture, Industry and Innovation January 2017 - March 1, 2018. I would like the amount and reason for payment to Norcon Marine Services Ltd.

Please be advised that the Deputy Minister for the Department of Tourism, Culture, Industry and Innovation has reviewed this request and the Department has no records responsive to your request.

The list provided in request TCII/9/2018 was based on approved grants during the time period of January 2017 to March 1, 2018. In response to your question, Norcon Marine Services Ltd received \$0.00. A grant of \$8000.00 was approved by the Department for Norcon Marine Services Ltd to join the NAIA Cod Growout Mission in Greenland and Norway in May 2017 however due to Norcon not participating in the mission, the total project was cancelled.

Please be advised that you may ask the Information and Privacy Commissioner to review the processing of your access request, as set out in section 42 of the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (the *Act*). A request to the Commissioner must be made in writing within 15 business days of the date of this letter or within a longer period that may be allowed by the Commissioner.
