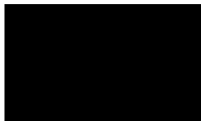

Re: Your request for access to information under Part II of the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act, 2015* [Our File #: MAE/023/2019]

On January 31, 2019, the Department of Municipal Affairs and Environment received your request for access to the following records/information:

"Please provide a list of all external consulting contracts commenced or renewed since Dec. 1, 2015. For each instance, please specify the name of the individual or company consulting, the date the contract was initially commenced or renewed, the date the contract was concluded (or, if it's still ongoing, please specify) and the total dollar figure paid to date to the consultant for that project."

In a subsequent email sent on February 21, 2019, you clarified what type of information you are looking for, which was stated as follows:

"I am looking for any contracts related to:

- drafting of legislation*
- interpretation of legislation*
- compliance of government policy or programs with legislation*
- legal risks and other assessment with respect to policy or draft policy*
- environmental assessments"*

I am pleased to inform you that a decision has been made by the Deputy Minister to provide access to the requested information. In accordance with your request for a copy of the records, the appropriate copies have been enclosed. Please note that the records enclosed in your responsive package includes a list of professional services (i.e. contracts) as per your ATIPP request that are: compliance of government policy or programs with legislation; legal risks and other assessment with respect to policy or draft policy; environment assessment and interpretation of legislation. In clarification of the list of professional service provided, your request states "contracts related to environment assessment", please note that Environment Assessment in this department refers to a specific division and legislated process. However, our Pollution Prevention division hires consultants to perform environmental site assessments on containment sites, contracts related to which are included in the list.

Please be advised that you may ask the Information and Privacy Commissioner to review the processing of your access request, as set out in section 42 of the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (the *Act*). A request to the Commissioner must be made in writing within 15 business days of the date of this letter or within a longer period that may be allowed by the Commissioner.

You may also appeal directly to the Supreme Court Trial Division within 15 business days after you receive the decision of the public body, pursuant to section 52 of the *Act*.

Please be advised that responsive records will be published following a 72 hour period after the response is sent electronically to you or five business days in the case where records are mailed to you. It is the goal to have the responsive records posted to the Completed Access to Information Requests website within one business day following the applicable period of time. Please note that requests for personal information will not be posted online.
