**Re: Your request for access to information under Part II of the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act, 2015* [Our File #: AESL/084/2019]**

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On November 14, 2019 the Department of Advanced Education, Skills and Labour received your request for access to the following records/information:

**“Any emails between the Minister of AESL (or staff) to members of the MUN Board of Regents (including Dr. Noreen Golfman and Dr. Gary Kachanoski) from June 1, 2019 to the date of this request.”**

Please note that the email accounts of the Director of Literacy and Institutional Services, Assistant Deputy Minister of Post-Secondary Education, Deputy Minister and Minister were included in the search for responsive records. Please note as well that your AESL/057/2019 request for these records included dates up to August 11, 2019, as such we conducted our search for records beginning August 12, 2019.

Please be advised that the Department of Advanced Education, Skills and Labour has no records responsive to your request.

The *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act, 2015* (act) requires us to provide an advisory response within 10 days of receiving the request. As this request has been completed prior to day 10, this letter also serves as our Advisory Response.

Please be advised that you may ask the Information and Privacy Commissioner to review the processing of your access request, as set out in section 42 of the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (the Act). A request to the Commissioner must be made in writing within 15 business days of the date of this letter or within a longer period that may be allowed by the Commissioner.

It is the goal to have the letter posted to the Completed Access to Information Requests website within one business day following the applicable period of time. Please note that requests for personal information will not be posted online.
