Re: Your request for access to information under Part II of the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (File # NR-260-2019)

On December 9, 2019, the Department of Natural Resources received your request for access to the following records/information:

[REDACTED] correspondence from Service NL dated October 24, 2019, under file no GA/GSC/9720 (the "ESA Notice Letter") in regards to an alleged contamination (including the release of diesel fuel and motor oil) at a location referenced as coordinates 48° 30'22.35"N, 54°12'42.75"W, Terra Nova, NL. We are seeking all documentation in control of the public body regarding the alleged impacted site located at coordinates 48° 30'22.35"N, 54°12'42.75"W, Terra Nova, NL, and particularly, all documentation available related to past activities or the discovery of the alleged contamination or impacted site at, or proximate to, the said location in the ESA Notice Letter.

The Department of Natural Resources have reviewed this request and conducted a search and confirmed that there are no responsive records available.

Please be advised that you may ask the Information and Privacy Commissioner to review the processing of your access request, as set out in section 42 of the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (the *Act*). A request to the Commissioner must be made in writing within 15 business days of the date of this letter or within a longer period that may be allowed by the Commissioner.
