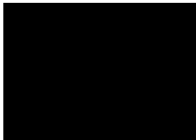

Re: Your request for access to information under Part II of the **Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act, 2015** OSW/1/2020

On February 25, 2020, The Office of the Status of Women (OSW) received your request for access to the following records:

A list of all appointments made by the various ministers of your department, and all predecessor departments, during the period of November 6, 2003 to December 14, 2015. Include appointees' names, the date of appointment, and the appointed position.

Please be advised the OSW has reviewed this request and the OSW has no records responsive to your request. The **Status of Women Advisory Council Act** directs the Lieutenant Governor in Council to appoint eleven members to the Provincial Advisory Council on the Status of Women (PACSW).

You can access the record of appointments from November 6, 2003 until December 14, 2015, by reviewing PACSW's and OSW's Annual Reports, which are public facing documents, found at <https://www.gov.nl.ca/exec/osw/publications/>

The Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act, 2015 (the "Act") requires us to provide an advisory response within 10 business days of receiving the request. As this request has been completed prior to day 10, this letter also serves as our Advisory Response.

Please be advised that you may ask the Information and Privacy Commissioner to review the processing of your access request, as set out in section 42 of **the Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act, 2015** (the Act) (a copy of this section has been enclosed for your reference). A request to the Commissioner must be made in writing within 15 business days of the date of this letter or within a longer period that may be allowed by the Commissioner.
