Re: Your request for access to information under Part II of the Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act, 2015 [Our File #: MAE/030/2020]

On February 17, 2020, the Department of Municipal Affairs and Environment received your request for access to the following records/information:

“Looking for a list of Fire Department that got new or used trucks or took the hundred thousand in the last three years (tankers, pumpers, rescue, rural response or aerial)”

I am pleased to inform you that a decision has been made by the Deputy Minister to provide access to the requested information. In accordance with your request for a copy of the records, the appropriate copy is enclosed. Please note that the ‘fixed’ in the third column indicates that this is a new vehicle and is also referring to the funding stream the municipality determined to be most suitable. Under this program option, the municipality would be eligible for a maximum fixed contribution of \$100,000 toward the purchase of one of the following new vehicles: pumper; pumper rescue; aerial; tanker; or rescue. Please be advised that you may ask the Information and Privacy Commissioner to review the processing of your access request, as set out in section 42 of the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (the *Act*). A request to the Commissioner must be made in writing within 15 business days of the date of this letter or within a longer period that may be allowed by the Commissioner.

You may also appeal directly to the Supreme Court Trial Division within 15 business days after you receive the decision of the public body, pursuant to section 52 of the *Act*.

Please be advised that responsive records will be published following a 72 hour period after the response is sent electronically to you or five business days in the case where records are mailed to you. It is the goal to have the responsive records posted to the Completed Access to Information Requests website within one business day following the applicable period of time. Please note that requests for personal information will not be posted online.
